IRCS-OSB is committed to the services with more vigour and vitality for mitigating the sufferings of people.



## Introduction

The Indian Red Cross Society, Odisha State Branch( IRCS-OSB) has been rendering humanitarian services to the people of Odisha since 1<sup>st</sup> April, 1936. The IRCS was established in 1920 through an Act of the Parliament, the bill passed on 17<sup>th</sup> March, 1920 and became Act XV of 1920 with the consent of the Governor General on 20<sup>th</sup> March, 1920. All its humanitarian activities are based on the four core areas i.e Disaster Response, Disaster Preparedness, Health & Care in the Community and Promotion of Humanitarian Values & Fundamental Principles. Binding by Seven Fundamental Principles i.e. Humanity, Impartiality, Neutrality, Independence, Voluntary Service, Unity and Universality, the Indian Red Cross Society, Odisha State Branch has promoted mutual understanding, friendship, cooperation and lasting peace amongst all people. It has 30 District Branches, 1 City Branch, 1 Regional Branch besides Junior Red Cross and Youth Red Cross Units schools and colleges of Odisha.

Now Indian Red Cross Society, Odisha State Branch has completed 89 glorious years of dedicated service for the cause of humanity.

The State Branch has undertaken a number of measures to introduce a systematic change in overall functioning of the Branch during the FY 2023-24. The report underlines the activities undertaken during the year towards improving the lives of vulnerable people mitigating their sufferings and mobilising the power of humanity in promoting disaster preparedness and health & care to the community.

# IRCS, Odisha State Branch

## 1. Working Committee Meeting of IRCS,OSB held on 29.12.2023:

The State Working Committee meeting of IRCS-OSB was organised at Red Cross Bhavan, Bhubaneswar on December 29, 2023 at 10.30 A.M.under the chairmanship of Sri Niranjan Pujari, Hon'ble Minister, Health & Family Welfare & Chairman, Working Committee and presided over the meeting, Miss SaliniPandit, I.A.S., the Commissioner cum Secretary to Govt. Health & Family Welfare Dept. and Vice Chairman, Working Committee was present in the above meeting. Shri Bibhuti BhusanPattnaik, IAS (Retd.) Honorary Secretary, IRCS-OSB discussed the agenda items and highlighted a few initiatives undertaken by the IRCS, Odisha State Branch during 2023.

In the above meeting the Working Committee reviewed and appreciated the Action Taken Report on the Proceedings of the last meeting. Different administrative & financial approvals were accorded.



## 2. Inauguration Of Red Cross Regional Blood Centre, Bhubaneswar:

The Red Cross Regional Blood Centre, Bhubaneswar was inaugurated inside the premises of Indian Red Cross Society, Odisha State Branch on 1<sup>st</sup> April , 2023 (Utkal Divas) at 11.30 A.M. under the guidance of Honorary Secretary, IRCSOSB.

Hon. Governor of Odisha & President of Indian Red Cross Society, Odisha State Branch (IRCS-OSB) has inaugurated the Blood Centre in presence of Hon'ble Health & Family Welfare Minister, Hon'ble School & Mass Education Minister, Principal Secretary to Hon'ble Governor & other dignitaries. This Blood Centre will cater the blood requirements of most of the Hospitals, Nursing Homes and General Public of Bhubaneswar City and near by areas.

On this occasion a State Level Meeting was organised at the Conference Hall and Voluntary Blood Donation Camp was organised in the Red Cross Regional Blood Centre, Red Cross Bhavan, Bhubaneswar. The Local Youth Volunteers from different colleges of donated blood in the aforesaid camp. With the participation of other stakeholders a total numbers of 55 Units of blood was collected in the camp.

### 3. Observance of World Red Cross Day-2023

## **5. Programme for Visually Impaired :-**

Indian Red Cross Society, Odisha State Branch is implementing the Vision Restoration Programme for Visually Impaired Children of all blind schools in partnership with L.V Prasad Eye Institute, Bhubaneswar. In this connection a meeting was held on 15.04.2023 at L.V Prasad Eye Institute, Patia, Bhubaneswar on proposal of Visually Impaired programme in Blind School. Based on the decision in the meeting, IRCS,OSB has started the programme initially in Khordha District. Eye Institute of visually impaired students in collaboration with L.V Prasad Eye Institute, Patia, has done to find out cases for restoration of vision at least partially.

Note: After the eye screening, 133 students of the blind schools were referred to L.V Prasad Eye Institute for eye checkup. Out of them, 58 blind students participated in the eye checkup. After eye checkup only six students were identified for surgery. Out of the above 6 students, 4 students have already completed their surgery and after completion of the surgery process, the vision of two blind students have partially recovered.

## **6. Quarterly Life Members' Meeting:**

In addition, the Institute of Health Science, Bhubaneswar is conducting different academic programmes for manpower development in Disability Studies, Health Care & Rehabilitation Sciences to cater to the perceived needs in the country.

In this inaugural function, More than 600 Red Cross Volunteers from Youth Red Cross, Junior Red Cross, District Red Cross, Life Members and Staff members joined the social service camp for rendering different services to the devotees.

### **DISASTER MANAGEMENT UNIT**

**Disaster Management Unit:** This Unit looks after the relief and rehabilitation of the victims. Before disaster strikes it makes people aware of the probable effects on people and society. All steps required to rescue and rehabilitation of the victims, First Aid support, medicines, food and other materials, are taken by this Unit.

► **Distribution of Relief Materials and Hygiene kits at Mayurbhanj District on 12<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> April,2023:**

➤ **Train Tragedy at Bahanaga, Balasore:**

On the 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 2023 three trains collided at Bahanaga of Balasore District. Salimar Chennai Coromandal Express, Yashwantpur Hawarh Super fast Express collided with a stationary freight train. Near about 300 people died & thousand injured. On the same day Dr. Ramesh Chandra Behera, YRCO and Laxman Swain, JRCO himself rushed to the train accidental spot at Bahanaga and coordinated all the emergency services with mobilizing counsellors and volunteers & provided emergency services like First-aid, crowed management, dead body management carrying the injured to hospital etc. They also provided food, water to the injured person at different Hospitals like Soro, Balasore, Bhadrak & Cuttack. For providing Blood to the accidental victims, YRC/JRC Counsellors of Balasore, Bhadrak & Cuttack arranged blood donation Camp & donated blood to save many priceless lives. They also distributed cooked food & water to the relatives of the victims, the persons engaged in rescue operation like fire men, ODRAF, NDRF etc.

The downtrodden, poor and helpless persons are the main beneficiaries. The programme was held by involving 70 above local residents including adolescent girls, women, men, Asha and Anganwadi workers. The main objective of the Awareness programme was to promote family counselling. With the span of time and introduction of modernity the value of family life in some cases have been derogated.



With small misunderstandings the family life become strained and lead to divorce or judicial separation. In these cases most of the time they need a third party intervention who can discuss with them and can resolve the misunderstandings. There was discussion on various issues related to family counselling centre including Dowry, Domestic violence, Extramarital relation, Family property dispute, premarital Counselling etc.


### III. Observation of International Women's Day – 2024:
